

Letter posted Winchester Oct 23 1840
to Albert Whitehead, Baltonsborough

My dear Albert,

The hops are for Mr. Lang Hambridge, Mr. Hewett Norton, Mr. Bruford Taunton and Mr. Knight Bridgwater 42 Po. Mr. Hewetts will be left at Mr. Bruford's with two packets of Kent hops. F. Gill & Pester have the particulars more explicitly than I now give you from memory.

I think I should keep back 10 of the fattest ewes and sell the others at Wells if you see any Devon lambs fat buy them. You will get a letter from me at the Post Office Wells Monday:

With two or three cheques signed for Giblett & Webber, pay Giblett for the whole we have taken. I sent back by Longman from Salisbury 8 sacks of the Golden drop wheat expect he left it at Mullens > or Isaac Seymore < sow this at Barton 4 furrowsedge (?) get the turnips home from Scotch Bank I have bo't a sack of hatches to sow there. Love to Mother and Mary Ann
